P3 and The Service Delivery Model



The Program Team theme of “P-To-The-Three” is our dramatic way of motivating chapters to move programming to higher award winning levels.

Many chapters are working at the **FIRST LEVEL - PARTY**, where a single event or fundraiser is viewed as a chapter program. No real thought is given to measurable goals; the emphasis is on the **PARTY** or event. One or two people run everything and everyone.

Other chapters may be ready to move towards the **SECOND LEVEL - PLANNING**. Chapters are beginning to add goals and objectives along with their activities; facets are getting involved in some planning of the budget and activities. Wheels are turning, work is being done, but not all chapter members are vested in the success of the program. There is very little impact on the community and less than a fourth of the chapter is involved.

The **THIRD LEVEL – QUALITY PROGRAMMING** begins with a strong foundation of a Community Needs Assessment and a Chapter Assessment. The Community Assessment reveals the unique needs and conditions of the community while the chapter assessment determines the skills and expertise within a chapter. These two tools are essential as chapters begin to prioritize their goals and objectives. Quality Programs work best when the entire chapter is involved and excited about their programs. Umbrella Programs are well suited to involving all chapter members with all facets working towards a common goal. Goals are measurable and are reviewed annually to make sure that objectives are being met. Another strong element of this third level is increased impact in the community. **NOW WE HAVE AN AWARD WINNING PROGRAM.**
